Treat each other with respect. Appropriate behavior and language is expected. No tobacco, lighters/matches, alcohol, drugs, knives, lasers or weapons of any kind are allowed. No public display of affection or inappropriate physical contact. Please tell another student or chaperone if you will be absent from a ski trip.</p> <p>BUS RULES You must remain seated in your seat at all times. This rule is for your safety and if not adhered to you will be moved to another seat or another bus. You may begin to put your gear on when the bus captain makes the announcement. For safety reasons, all preparations must stop when the bus enters the Alpentel Road and you will finish with gear when the bus stops in the ski area parking lot. You will be expected to keep the area around you clean and any garbage you have needs to be put in the trash. Boots cannot be stored in the overhead compartments unless they are put inside of carry-on bags. Please store them under the seat in front of you.</p> <p>SKI AREA RULES Students must report to their lesson and remain with their instructor throughout the lesson. You MUST wear your HELMET while on the hill. Students are required to check-in with your chaperone at the lodge after your lesson and tell who you will be skiing with and where. Ski with AT LEAST one other person from our program during free ski time. Skiing / Boarding alone is NOT ALLOWED. Do not bring another skier to a run that is too difficult or that has not been approved by their instructor. Do not ski in trees or closed off areas. Stay in Bounds, ski in control and adhere to OLF standards. Report to your bus ON TIME at the end of the evening.
